Céad Míle Fáilte – A Hundred Thousand Welcomes

Céad Míle Fáilte (*kayd mee-luh fawl-cha*) is an Irish phrase that reflects the warmth, openness, and hospitality for which Ireland is known. Set on the Atlantic edge of Europe, Ireland is a small island nation of just over five million people, shaped by its western coastline, rich cultural heritage, and strong sense of community.

As hosts of the ENTOG Exchange and Scientific Meeting 2026, Ireland welcomes trainees from across Europe to experience its training culture, hospitality, and shared commitment to global women's health through collaboration, learning, and meaningful exchange.



6 September | Arrival to Ireland

- Most exchange participants will arrive via **Dublin** or **Cork** Airport and then travel onward to their assigned host hospital.
- Accommodation during the clinical exchange will be arranged by the host, either with host trainees or in hospital accommodation. You are also very welcome to organise your own stay at your own expense.



7 – 10 September | Clinical Exchange

- **During working hours**, exchange participants will join hospital clinical activities in an observership capacity. This will include time in the labour ward, operating theatres, outpatient clinics, and other specialist services.
- Outside hospital hours, **a social programme** will offer opportunities for sightseeing, cultural experiences, and integration into local daily life — including time to explore Ireland's charming and picturesque towns. Activities will vary between cities, but each host team looks forward to sharing their local culture and hospitality.
- Participants based outside Dublin may also choose to travel to Dublin on 10 September to explore the capital city before the ENTOG meetings begin.

11 September | Council Meeting & Social Evening

- Exchange participants will gather at **The Coombe Hospital, Dublin** to join ENTOG Country Representatives for the Council Meeting and Workshop Seminar. Three exchange participants will be selected in advance to present their exchange experience during the meeting. Elections for the ENTOG Executive Committee 2025/2026 will also take place.
- In the evening, everyone will come together for the **ENTOG Social Evening**.

12 September | Scientific Meeting

- The ENTOG Scientific Meeting will focus on the theme of **Global Women's Health**. Exchange participants and Country Representatives will take part in a themed roundtable discussion, sharing key challenges from their own countries and learning from each other's approaches and solutions. The programme will also feature invited speakers addressing important global women's health issues.
- The **full programme will be released in summer 2026**, and registration for the Scientific Meeting will open at that time.





Registration & Allocation of Exchange Places

National trainee societies in each ENTOG member country will be responsible for selecting their participants.

- Because of the structure of Irish Obstetrics & Gynaecology training, we will initially offer **one clinical exchange place** to each ENTOG member country.
- In summer 2026, we will be able to offer a **second place** to *selected* countries following further discussion with the ENTOG Executive Committee.

€150

- This category is for ENTOG members **not** joining the clinical exchange.
- It also includes participation in the ENTOG Council Meeting & Workshop Seminar, ENTOG Social Evening, and the ENTOG Scientific Meeting.

Accommodation during the ENTOG Council Meeting and Scientific Meeting is not included and **must be arranged separately** by participants.
